## Logo

#### **OVERVIEW**

SAI Platform's logo has two versions: An outlined single-colour variant, and a solid, full-colour alternative. The outlined logo is the primary logo and is used to lead marketing materials, while the full-colour logo is used in a more supporting role (e.g. at the back of reports) and on official documentation.

## Logo

#### RULES

Both logos should retain their integrity and not be alerted structurally, or have any effects applied. The only legitimate change permitted is the colour of the outlined logo (see next page).

#### Do not...

alter the colour of the logo\*

#### Do not...

alter the scale of logo elements









#### Do not...

distort or stretch the logo

#### Do not...

apply effects to the logo









<sup>\*</sup>Although the outlined logo can be displayed in a selection of brand colours, only one colour can be used at a time.



## Logo

#### RULES

The full-colour logo has a white outline stroke, meaning it can be placed on any background colour and maintain its legibility.

The outlined logo should be brand grey as standard, but can also be displayed in other brand colours, or white on dark backgrounds and imagery.

The following rules apply for the application of the outlined logo:

#### Do...

use darker outline logo against light backgrounds



#### Do...

use white outline logo against dark backgrounds



#### Do...


use white outline logo against images with sufficient contrast



## Colour

#### CORE PALETTE

The core SAI Platform brand palette is led with dark grey and light green. Bright green is used for prominent highlights, with yellow used sparingly on additional highlight elements. Greys are a useful alternative to the light green for backgrounds.





## Colour

#### SECONDARY PALETTE

The minimal core palette is effective and secondary colours should only be introduced where additional swatches are necessary – e.g. in charts and graphs, or layout formats where more colours are required. Colours that fall within the Tier 1 should be introduced first, followed by Tier 2.






## Colour

#### APPLICATION

The graphs below demonstrate how the secondary palette can be added alongide the core colours. Bright Green and Yellow are the leading colours from the core palette, followed by the three Tier 1 colours from the secondary palette, and then Tier 2.




## **Graphics**
